Beginning and ending in Dibrugarh, the journey takes you through some of the most remote and least explored regions of the state — from the scenic valleys of Aalo and Mechuka in **Shi-Yomi district** to the pristine wilderness of **Anini and Dibang Valley**.

The journey unfolds slowly and meaningfully, allowing you to truly experience Arunachal's raw landscapes, tribal cultures, and dramatic terrain. You'll cross iconic river bridges, drive through dense forests and high mountain passes, explore border regions near the India–China frontier, trek through untouched grasslands, and discover hidden waterfalls deep inside tribal villages.

This itinerary blends **scenic road journeys, cultural immersion, soft adventure, and nature exploration**. From monasteries and riverside picnics in Mechuka to trekking in Emuli Grasslands and camping near waterfalls in Dibang Valley, every day brings a new landscape and a deeper connection to the land. Accommodation includes a thoughtful mix of hotels, homestays, and campsites, ensuring comfort while staying close to nature and local life. Expect long but rewarding drives, basic facilities in remote areas, changing weather, limited connectivity, and experiences that go far beyond ordinary sightseeing.

If you're looking for a **true expedition-style journey** that covers Arunachal's most untouched regions with patience, depth, and authenticity, this 11-day itinerary offers one of the most complete offbeat experiences in Northeast India.

Duration: 11 Days / 10 Nights

Start & End Point: Dibrugarh

Trip Highlights

- Scenic drive from Dibrugarh crossing the iconic **Bogibeel Bridge** over the Brahmaputra River.
- Explore **Aalo**, the cultural gateway to West Siang, with village walks and river views.
- Journey to **Mechuka (Shi-Yomi district)** through dramatic mountain roads via Kaying and Tato.
- Visit **Samten Yongcha Monastery**, Gurudwara Mechuka, Hanuman Camp, and hanging bridges.

- Cultural immersion with the **Memba tribe**, village visits, and riverside picnics along the Siom River.
- Optional excursion to **Lanbang Border viewpoint** and the IAF helicopter crash site (subject to access).
- Scenic drive to **Pasighat**, experiencing the Siang River valley and Adi tribal regions.
- Travel deep into **Dibang Valley**, crossing **Mayudia Pass (8,711 ft)** en route to Anini.
- Explore **Anini**, one of Arunachal's most remote Himalayan towns, surrounded by pristine wilderness.
- Day trip to **Acheso village**, visiting hidden gems like **Chigu Waterfall** and **Mawu Falls**.
- Trek through forests and alpine meadows to the breathtaking **Emuli Grasslands**, dotted with wildflowers and grazing yaks.
- Experience camping options at **Dree Afra / Chigu Camp** for a truly off-grid experience.
- Visit **Namsai's Golden Pagoda** and TungTao Resort on the return journey.
- Travel with a local Northeast-based team that includes **hidden, lesser-known places whenever conditions allow**.

Travel Plan :

Day 1: Arrival at Dibrugarh – Journey to Aalo

- Your adventure begins as our Wild Hill Adventure driver greets you at Dibrugarh Airport.
- Start the drive to Aalo, crossing the engineering marvel of Bogibeel Bridge.
- Stop at local tribal villages and enjoy an authentic lunch.
- Arrive in Aalo (Along), check into your stay, and take a leisurely stroll around town.
- Overnight stay in Aalo.

Day 2: Aalo to Mechuka

- After breakfast, begin the scenic drive to Mechuka, weaving through dramatic mountains and valleys.
- Make stops at hanging bridges, waterfalls, and tribal hamlets.
- Expect challenging roads after Kaying and Tato.
- Arrive in Mechuka, check into your guesthouse, and explore the peaceful town.
- Overnight stay in Mechuka.

Day 3: Mechuka Local Discovery – Heart of the Valley

- Explore Mechuka's charm with a local guide.
- Visit Samten Yongcha Monastery, Gurudwara Mechuka, and Hanuman Camp.

- Enjoy a picnic lunch by the Siom River.
- Optionally, visit the Lanbang Border Viewpoint and the IAF helicopter crash site (if accessible).
- Overnight stay in Mechuka.

Day 4: Mechuka Activities & Cultural Immersion – Beyond the Sights

- Immerse yourself in Memba tribal culture with visits to nearby villages.
- Go for a short trek to Dorjeeling Hilltop or try mountain biking.
- Explore Dorjeeling Village and Salman Khan Viewpoint.
- Enjoy a relaxed lunch amidst Himalayan landscapes.
- Evening at leisure in Mechuka.
- Overnight stay in Mechuka.

Day 5: Mechuka to Pasighat

- Enjoy an early breakfast before a long, scenic drive to Pasighat.
- Cross bamboo hanging bridges and diverse landscapes.
- Arrive by evening, stroll along the Siang River, and try local Adi cuisine for dinner.
- Overnight stay in Pasighat.

Day 6: Pasighat to Roing

- After breakfast, take a shorter drive to Roing.
- Arrive by afternoon, check in, and relax.
- Explore local lakes or archaeological sites in the evening.
- Overnight stay in Roing.

Day 7: Roing to Anini

- Drive deep into the Mishmi Hills toward Anini, following the Dibang River.
- Stop at Mayudia Pass (8,711 ft), often blanketed in snow.
- Arrive in Anini by evening and soak in its pristine beauty.
- Overnight stay in Anini (campsite, homestay, or resort).

Day 8: Day Trip to Acheso – Chigu & Mawu Waterfalls

- After breakfast, enjoy a day trip to Acheso village.
- Visit Chigu Waterfall and the mesmerizing Mawu Falls.
- Return to Anini or opt for an overnight camp stay at Dree Afra.
- Overnight stay in Anini / Dree Afra Camp / Chigu Camp.

Day 9: Emuli Grassland Trek – Nature's Canvas

- Begin the day with breakfast and a short drive to the Emuli trailhead.
- Embark on a 4–5 hour trek through lush forests and highland meadows.
- Discover the breathtaking Emuli Grasslands, dotted with wildflowers

and grazing yaks. Enjoy a packed lunch before returning to Anini.

- Overnight stay in Anini.

Day 10: Anini to Dibrugarh

- Post breakfast, begin your journey back to Dibrugarh.
- Stop at picturesque viewpoints, village markets, and Mayudia Pass for one last look at its charm.
- Drive to Namsai.
- Visit TungTao Resort (7 km resort) and the Golden Pagoda.
- Continue driving to Dibrugarh.
- Overnight stay in Dibrugarh.

Day 11: Dibrugarh – Departure

- After breakfast, drive to the airport for your departure.
- Your Adventurous and mesmerising trip ends with unforgettable memories.
