The adventure begins with a drive into South Garo Hills, one of Meghalaya's least explored regions, leading to the hidden natural wonder of **Wari Chora** — a dramatic gorge with towering rock walls and crystal-clear waters. This offbeat experience sets the tone for a journey that balances exploration, nature, and slow travel.

As the trip progresses, you'll discover limestone caves, powerful waterfalls, emerald rivers, clean villages, and living root bridges. From boating through narrow gorges and exploring ancient cave systems to enjoying the famous Umngot River in Dawki and the misty landscapes of Cherrapunji, every day brings a new contrast of terrain and experience.

Stays include comfortable hotels, homestays, and campsites, offering a mix of comfort and authentic local hospitality. Expect adventurous drives, basic facilities in remote areas, changing weather, and unforgettable landscapes shaped by rain, rivers, and time.

- Explore Wari Chora, a hidden river gorge accessed by off-road vehicles and guided boat rides.

- Visit the Jadesil Fish Sanctuary, known for its pristine river ecosystem.
- Explore Siju Cave (Bat Cave), one of India's longest limestone cave systems, along with the unique Rongchang Rock Formation.
- Journey to Shillong with scenic stops and hill viewpoints along the way.
- Visit the stunning Krang Suri Falls and the majestic Phe Phe Falls in the Jaintia Hills.

- Experience the crystal-clear waters of the Umngot River at Dawki with boating and optional adventure activities at Shnongpdeng.
- Explore Mawlynnong village, once known as the cleanest village in Asia, including its Living Root Bridge and Balancing Rock.
- Witness the dramatic beauty of Nohkalikai Falls and explore Cherrapunji's famous waterfalls and caves.
- Visit iconic Cherrapunji attractions such as Seven Sisters Falls, Mawsmai Cave, Garden of Caves, and Wei Sawdong Falls .
- **Travel with a local Northeast-based team that includes hidden spots whenever time and weather allow.**

Travel Plan :

Day 1: Guwahati to Siju

- Pick up from Guwahati Airport/hotel.
- Drive to Siju
- Pause along the way to capture some breathtaking landscapes.
- Arrive at Siju.
- Overnight stay in a campsite, homestay, or hotel.

Day 2: Explore Warichora Heaven on Earth

- Rise early and embark on an adventurous drive to the Warichora off-road trail.
- Trek to the Wari Wachora boating point. Live and experience Warichora beyond your imagination.
- Spend time there, then continue your journey to the Jadesil Fish Sanctuary, where you can swim with the fish and feed them.
- Spend a magical evening in Warichora.
- Overnight stay in a campsite, homestay, or hotel.

Day 3: Explore Siju Cave & Markham Valley then drive to Shillong

- Start your day with an early morning breakfast.
- Embark on a guided tour to explore Siju Cave & Rongchang Rock Formation.
- Drive to Shillong, enjoying beautiful landscapes along the way. On the way, visit Markham Valley - mini Dzukou Valley.
- In the evening, explore Police Bazaar and do local shopping.
- Café hopping and explore the nightlife in Shillong, the "Rock Capital" of India.
- Overnight stay in Shillong.

Day 4: Bamboo Trek Mawryngkhang

- Early morning breakfast.
- Get ready for a bamboo trek with a local guide. Test your adventurous soul on the Mawryngkhang Bamboo Trek, and learn the love story

behind the stone. According to local folklore, Mawryngkhang, a male rock, fell in love with Kthiang, a female rock. Kthiang was unhappily married to Mawpator, another male rock, who treated her poorly. Seeing her distress, Mawryngkhang offered Kthiang a sanctuary and invited her to come and live with him.

- After that, drive to Dawki.
- Overnight stay in Dawki, Mawlynnong, or Jowai.

Day 5: Dawki to Cleanest Village to Cherrapunjee

- Start your day with a boat ride on the crystal-clear waters of the Umngot River in Shnongpdeng. Other water sports like zip-lining, kayaking, cliff jumping, and snorkeling are available.
- Drive to Mawlynnong village, once known as the cleanest village in Asia.
- Discover the Single Living Root Bridge (just a 15-minute walk from the village) and the Balancing Rock.
- Visit Mawkdok Valley.
- Proceed to Cherrapunjee for an overnight stay.

Day 6: Cherrapunjee Sightseeing

- After breakfast, explore Cherrapunjee.
- Visit : **7 Sister Falls, Mawsmai Cave, Gardens of Cave, Noh Ka Likai Falls, Arwah Cave, Wah-Kaba Falls, Dainthlen Falls, Wei Saw Dong Falls, and Lyngksiar Falls.**
- Overnight stay in Cherrapunjee.

Day 7: Double Decker Living Root Bridge

- Depart early at 6 AM and travel to Tyrna village.
- Test your physical endurance by trekking down 3,700 steps to reach the beautiful village of Nongriat.
- Experience the pride of Meghalaya: the famous Double Decker Living Root Bridge.
- Continue trekking to Rainbow Falls, passing several picturesque suspension bridges and rivers.
- Overnight stay in Shillong.

Day 8: Shillong to Guwahati

- After breakfast, visit Lady Hydari Park in Shillong.
- Explore the Cathedral Church and Wards Lake.
- Shop and buy souvenirs at Police Bazaar.
- Depart for Guwahati Airport/Khanapara.
- A memorable trip comes to an end with lots of incredible memories.
